

School Entry Immunization Requirements

All children entering school in West Virginia for the first time in grades pre-Kindergarten to 12th grade must show proof of the following immunizations:

Pre-Kindergarten

- Hepatitis A (2 doses)
- DTaP (4 doses)
- Polio (3 doses)
- Hib (4 doses)
- Hepatitis B (3 doses)
- Varicella (1 dose or history of disease)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (1 dose)
- PCV (4 doses)

Kindergarten to 12th Grade

- Hepatitis B (3 doses)
- DTaP (4 doses)
- Polio (3 doses)
- Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (2 doses)
- Varicella (2 doses or history of disease)

Additional School Entry Immunization Requirements Beginning in the 2012-2013 School Year

7th Grade Requirement

- Tdap (1 dose)
- Meningococcal (1 dose)

*There are no provisional enrollments permitted for the 7th grade requirements. Students must show proof of these vaccinations to enter 7th grade.

12th Grade Requirement

- Tdap (1 dose)
- Meningococcal (2nd dose required if the first dose was received before the 16th birthday)

*There are no provisional enrollments permitted for the 12th grade requirements. Students must show proof of these vaccinations to enter 12th grade.
