I. Call to order – Pledge of Allegiance – Introductions

President Estep called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. and asked for a moment of silence.

a. Lewis & Burge – Donation of air conditioners to Kingwood Elementary School Jill Zeigler, principal of Kingwood Elementary, presented a plague to representatives from Lewis & Burge for their recent donations and efforts in securing air conditioning units for Kingwood Elementary classrooms.

a. Elisha Buckingham – Mrs. Buckingham reported that one of her children had failed classes at the end of the first grading period as a result of not having textbooks to do his work. She asked for a resolution to this problem for all students in Preston County.

- a. **Superintendent's Report** Mr. Wotring reported that the auditor and his team was currently working in the county and that he had provided a questionnaire for each of the board members to complete.
- b. West Preston School LSIC (Enclosure IV.b) Mr. Graham reported results from the West Virginia General Summative Assessment with 5th grade scores being the highest scores along with 7th grade English/Language Arts, but that other achievement scores were not where they needed to be. It stated that student achievement was the number one priority for the school. He also shared that a robotics program had been started at the school and that there were many leadership opportunities for students. Lisa DeWitt spoke of the Positive Behavior Interventions and Support (PBIS) program and the success at the school. Irene Durr spoke of the Arthurdale Service Club and the many projects completed throughout the year.
- c. **Preston High School AEP Report** Brenda Walker and Stephen Martin presented a proposal for the Alternative Education Program (AEP) to begin November 1, 2016, at Preston High. This included a day and night program that was based upon student needs.
