Superintendent Wotring, Ms. Kerstetter, and Members of the Preston County BOE:

This spring Preston County Schools has sponsored girls' club volleyball during April and May at five district schools (Bruceston, Terra Alta / East Preston, South Preston, West Preston, and Central Preston). These club teams have included girls in grades 5-8 and these teams are not currently WVSSAC-affiliated or sanctioned. The overall goal of the girls' volleyball club teams has been to expose county middle school girls to the basics of volleyball and foster interest in the sport; conduct practices session a few days a week to improve overall skill level; play a limited in-county schedule of games to expose players to competitive games under standard conditions; and provide viable feeder school options for the Preston High School volleyball program.

This Spring over 150 girls have been participating on district club volleyball teams and five district schools (Bruceston, Terra Alta / East Preston, South Preston, West Preston, and Central Preston) have expressed an interest in pursuing the formation of WVSSAC-sanctioned teams for the 2018-19 school year. The sponsorship of WVSSAC-sanctioned middle school volleyball teams would assist the district in achieving improved Title IX compliance by providing a complimentary sport to offset unified football and will hopefully result in improved preparation of players feeding to the Preston High School Volleyball team.

This request is asking the BOE to approve five paid head coach positions at the previously mentioned schools for the 2018-19 school year. This request would not create any newly committed funding but would use budgeted funds for district athletic coaching positions that have been reconfigured as shown in the attached district coaching salary supplement. Equipment, uniforms, and other miscellaneous costs would be incurred by the schools that have requested programs. In addition, efforts would be made to obtain WVSSAC approval for interested students at Aurora and Rowlesburg to be granted permission to participate at a designated school that plans to offer a team. Please consider this request and feel free to contact either Mr. Brad Martin or Mr. Paul Martin with additional questions or concerns.

- The proposed actions above will budget for funding for all known / anticipated coaching positions at PHS and district middle school (pending BOE approval of middle school volleyball) for the 2018-19 school year. The funding for middle school volleyball is already in budget and was made available from funds originally scheduled for PHS Tennis and Swimming Head Coach and Assistant Head Coach positions (\$3000) and from funds originally scheduled for a Cheerleading Head Coach position at Rowlesburg (\$500). The funding created from the removal of track and cross county coaching positions at Rowlesburg (\$1300) will be used to offset the needed budgeted funds to sponsor boys' and girls' basketball coaching positions at all (7) district middle schools.
