

2020-21 Dress Code Policy and Consequences

Students & Families:

Just a friendly reminder that Preston High School, like most businesses and facilities, has a dress code.

According to the PHS Student Handbook from 2017 to date, the PHS Dress Code states:

School Administration will make final determinations concerning appropriateness of student apparel. Students are expected to dress in a manner that is not distracting to the educational process and is not a safety concern. Failure to comply with this policy may result in disciplinary action.

- Cleavage should not be visible
- No strapless tops or dresses
- No skin should show at the mid-riff area
- Shoulder straps must be 3 fingers wide
- Shorts/ skirts are no shorter than mid – thigh length
- No rips, tears, or holes above mid- thigh. Tights or leggings may be worn under jeans.
- No headgear or hats (unless approved in shop areas of CTE or in the cafeteria during lunch only)
- No gang, weapons, sex, alcohol, drug, profanity, tobacco, violence, nudity, or offensive symbols or slogans
- Under garments should not be visible
- No pajamas
- Clothing should not be excessively revealing
- Footwear must be worn

Personal hygiene should be sufficient as to not be distracting to other students. Please see your counselor for needed items.

Students who are out of dress code may choose from the following options:

1. Change into scrubs/sweatpants/different shirt/other clothing provided by the school and/or clothing the student has with them and attend the remainder of their classes for the day. At the end of the day, students may change back into the clothing in which they came to school. The clothing will be laundered for future use. Please send an email to the staff letting them know what the student is doing.
2. Call someone (friend/family member) to bring dress-code appropriate clothing to school. Student will sit in the Room 469 or 356 and remote learn while waiting on appropriate clothing to arrive at school, at which point they change into dress-code appropriate clothing and attend the remainder of their classes for the day. Please send an email to the staff letting them know what the student is doing.
3. Sit in Room 469 or 356 and remote learn for the remainder of the day.
